Inclusive Senior Education Through Virtual U3A



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Course title: Senior in the role of a teacher on the platform isev.osu.cz (moodle)

Course objective: The objective of the course is to familiarise the seniors with basic functions of system Moodle, which enables to tutor a course including inserting the course content and creating activities for students/seniors. The course provides basic knowledge and skills for the role of a teacher.

Time allocation: 9 lessons (1 lesson = 45 minutes)

Input requirements for the course participant: Knowledge of Moodle environment in the role of a student. Primarily:

- Logging into a course
- Profile editing
- Orientation in the course structure
- Viewing course content
- Submitting assignments
- Test completion
- Viewing grades
- Viewing users
- Communication in the course, such as sending messages to individual users
- Reading messages in forums, replying in forums, creating new topics in forums

Course annotation:

- Editing an existing course:
 - o Inserting and changing the content of study materials (description, file, URL)
 - Inserting and changing the content of activities (feedback, forum, chat, questionnaire, test, assignment)
 - Within a test, the following test tasks:
 - Multiple choice
 - True/False
 - Matching
 - Short answer
- Communication in the course:
 - o Forum creation
 - Activities in forums
 - Messages with attachments

- o Chats
- Course management:
 - o Setting
 - o Editing mode
 - o Users Editing enrolled users
 - o Reports
 - o Grades

Each partner organisation will have its own training course called Senior as a teacher. All participants of the blended mobility will have access to their courses (according to the organisation) in the role of a teacher. During blended mobility, the seniors will try to create a course and manage it so that they could use the experience in online piloting.

Online piloting

Online piloting will take place from October 2019 to January 2020. The trained seniors, participants of blended mobility, will be the teachers in courses/seminars which they attended in the previous semester. They will provide other seniors/students with materials and activities related to the topic of the given course/seminar. They will also prepare feedback reports and questionnaires as well as other activities for seniors/students.

The online piloting will follow up the blended mobility and will serve for practical verification of acquired knowledge and skills.
